Dear Homeowner:

On March 12, 2019, voters in the City of Hollywood approved a General Obligation Bond during a special election to fund various public improvement projects across the City. One of these projects includes the Tidal Flooding Mitigation and Shoreline Protection Project which aims to comply with Broward County and City ordinances regarding tidal flooding mitigation along City-owned shoreline segments adjacent to North Lake, South Lake and the Intercoastal Waterways. It is partly funded through a grant agreement from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's Office of Resilience and Coastal Protection.

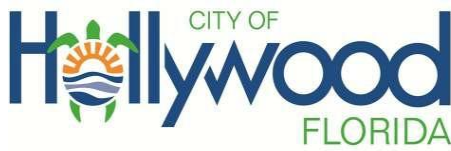
We are happy to announce construction of the seawall is nearing completion at all 4 sites with private boat docks. Preparation to start restoration and landscaping has already begun.

The project will affect the City-owned shoreline across the road from your property. For this purpose, we are providing a general overview of the upcoming activities, what to expect, and who to contact should you have any questions.

If you are leasing a boat dock, please note that you may begin to restore the dock utilities and dock approach over the new seawall. See below QR Code and Link for a Checklist and instructions regarding Permitting requirements.

Local traffic impacts are expected to be minimal, and access to your residence will be maintained throughout the entire construction period.

Landscape restorations are anticipated to begin in July for South Southlake Drive (Site 17), as shown on the map above. The entire project at Site 17 is anticipated to be completed by late August, 2026.

The City and the contractor continue to work together with all residents to minimize any impacts the project will have. 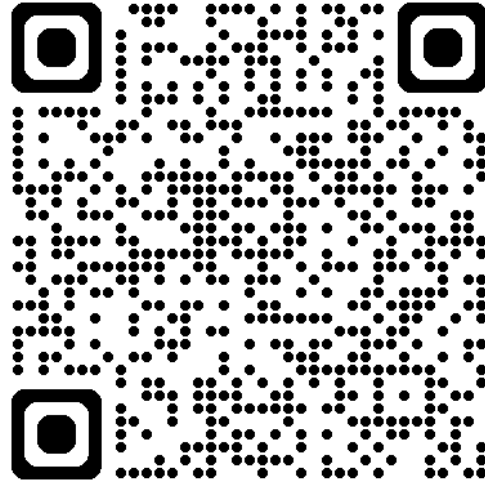
